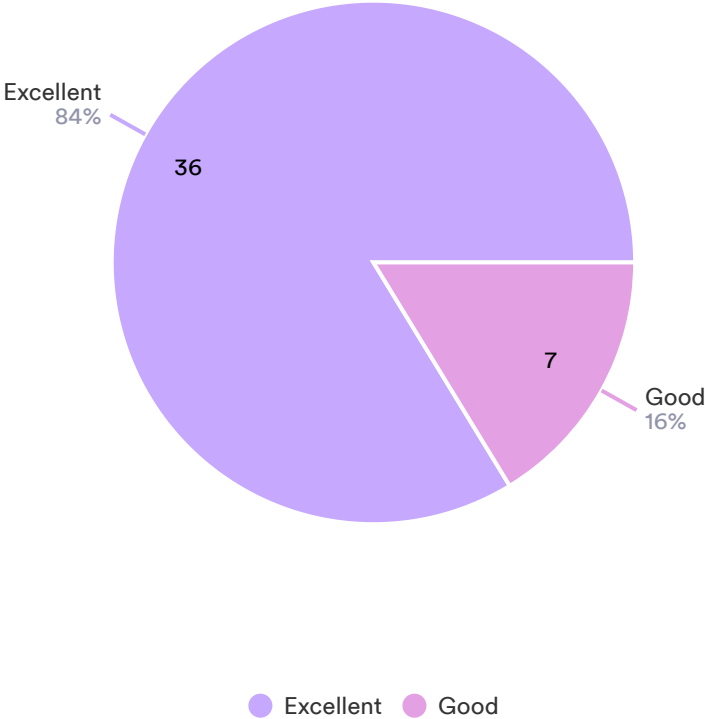

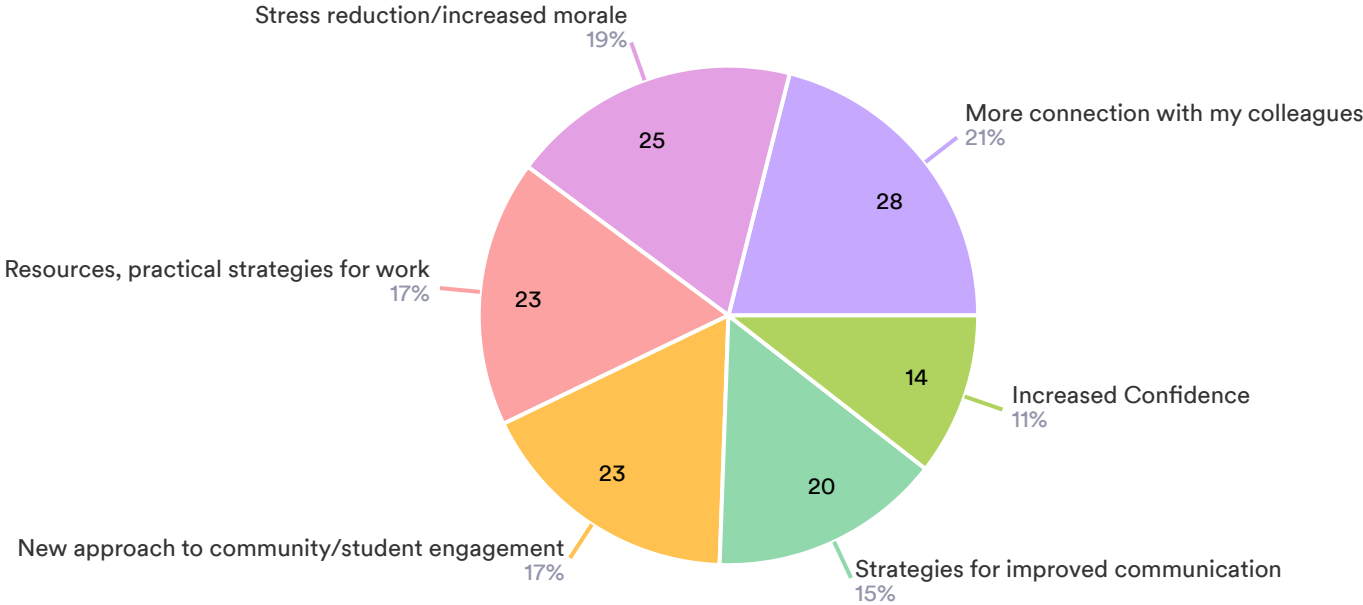
How would you rate your overall experience in this workshop?

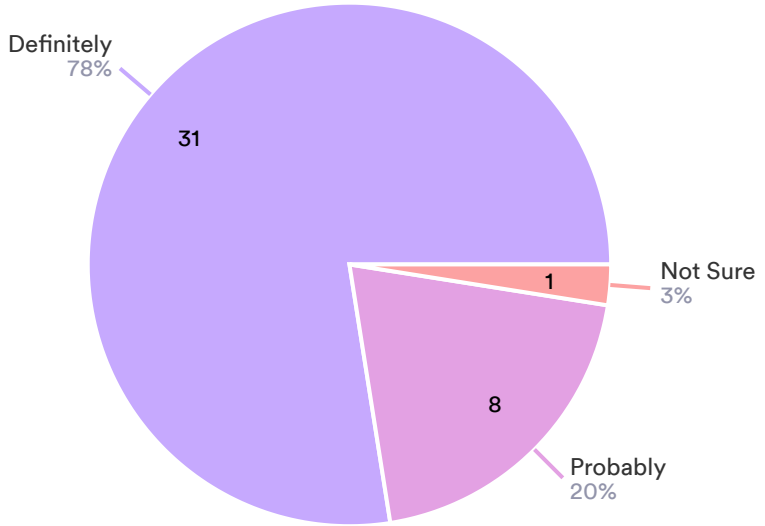
How likely are you to apply something from the workshop to your class/work?
